## C.S.I. Pollen workshop in Graz, 6.-7. February 2014

At the COLOSS conference in Kyiv, Jozef (Sjef) van der Steen and Robert Brodschneider presented the preliminary results of a pilote study that involves beekeepers as citizen scientists doing research on pollen diversity available to honey bees (Citizen scientist investigation on pollen forage available to honey bees). Researchers from other countries showed interest, we therefore aim of making this an international study.

## Aims of the workshop:

- Provide Articles for national beekeeping journals in different languages to promote this study
- Translate existing documents into different languages of countries that join the study in 2014
- Hands-on training for national coordinators
- Coordinate data collection and discuss advanced ways of analysis (GIS, statistical models)
- Establish troubleshooting strategies (e.g. FAQ) for communication with citizen scientists
- Importance of protein nutrition and biodiversity for honey bees will be presented and discussed in selected presentations

The workshop is open to everybody, although the number of participants is limited to 25 persons.
